Vernon Seminar

On October 16, businesses and strata management companies were invited to a complimentary Snow and Ice Control seminar at the Prestige Hotel in Vernon.

During an introduction to snow & ice management, GRM's Daniel Tomelin informed the attendees about the key features of GRM's plow, sanding, hauling, and anti ice services:

- 24/7 operational and committed
- Reliable and well maintained equipment
- Well instructed and certified operators
- "site ownership" for operators
- Pre-season site orientation
- Post-season spring clean-up
- Damage repair

Insurance specialist Michael Ostopowich of Kelowna Valley Insurance Services discussed liability insurance issues, and mentioned that GRM has a track record of good documented service work, which is key when it comes to determining liability in slip and fall situations. He stressed that individual contractors often assume that their snow pushing activities are being covered under their general liability insurance. However this is not the case. Underwriters need to be informed so that snow pushing can be included in the policy.

Retired meteorologist Henry Stanski presented historical data on the area's snowfall. He gave his perspective on weather forecasting and the influence of "El Nino" on our local weather.

GRM well equipped for the winter season

The GRM fleet includes a tandem axle truck that is equipped with a tank deck with 230 GPM hydraulic pump, 4 nozzles for street flushing, a rear mounted spray boom for Antilce application, a 3135 gallon tank for Antilce supply, an underbody plow, 20 and 30 yard roll off bins for snow hauling.

In addition, single axle road maintenance units with hydraulic driven sanders and under body plows, truck plows all equipped with a quick (dis) connect system, Antilce spray rigs, hopper sanders, tailgate sanders, Hwy sanders, skid steer buckets, skid steer plows, and side walk brushes. With over a hundred new and well maintained pieces of equipment lined up, GRM is ready to perform!
